


BACKPACKER PACKING SHIMS

Applications

Backpacker packing shims are used in hundreds of different applications in construction and DIY projects. These rot proof, water proof packers are used for levelling of battens, timber subframes, installation of door and window frames, drylining, levelling of kitchen and bathroom furniture, counter tops, sanitary ware, decking, garden buildings, first and second fix joinery and countless other situations requiring shimming, packing or levelling.



Sizes available

2 sizes – small (53mm x 43mm) and Standard (101mm x 43mm) in 1mm, 3mm, 5mm, 6mm and 10mm thicknesses.

Instructions for Use

Use Assorted Packs (or “project packs”) for general packing application where a variety of sizes are being used or Single Size Packs where the application requires a large number of the same thickness.

The “gate” feature on the Small Backpacker and the “comb” feature on the Standard Backpacker have been designed to allow the packer to be pushed over a fixing prior to tightening up and prevent the packer from falling out.

When filling a space or gap, always use the largest size possible to minimize the number of packers needed. The sizes of packers offered will, when used in combination, fill any gap in 1mm increments from 1mm upwards.

Choose either the Small or Standard packer according to the depth of the item to be packed – for example, a 60mm batten should be packed with a Small packer whereas the Standard packer would be the best to use on a door frame.
