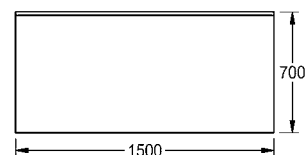
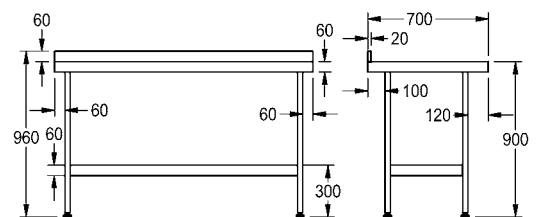

Assembly instructions for underframes supplied with Franke Sissons catering sinks and preparation tables

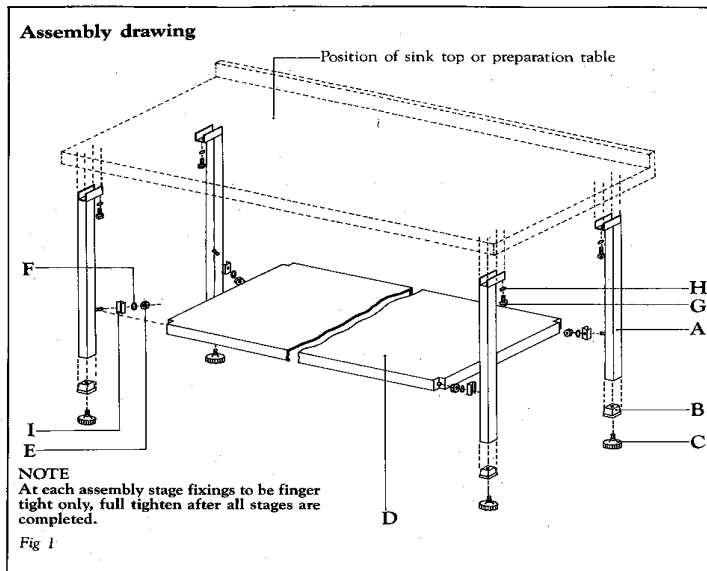

NB A mallet will be required for the plastic feet assembly and 12mm and 17mm box spanners for tightening the fixings.

NOTE

The above sketch shows the general exploded view in order to assist with the assembly of the underframe. However for the fixing of the undershelf to the leg support please follow the instructions in figure 4 - This relates specifically to the positioning and fixing of parts E, F and I, which are to fit on the inside of the undershelf, and not in the position as shown on the exploded view.

The above sketch shows the general exploded view in order to assist with the assembly of the underframe. However for the fixing of the undershelf to the leg support please follow the instructions in figure 4 - this relates specifically to the positioning and fixing of parts E, F and I, which are to fit on the inside of the undershelf, and not in the position as shown on the exploded view.

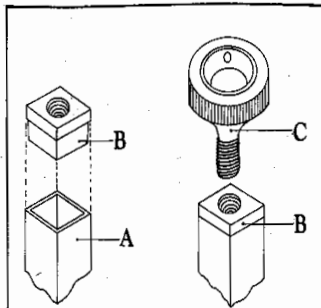

Gently tap the plastic feet inserts (B) into the bottom of the legs (A) using a mallet to ensure a full location. Repeat procedure on all legs.

Screw in plastic feet (C) into leg inserts (B). Repeat procedure on all legs.

Centre leg details

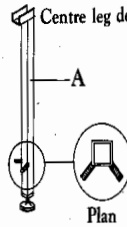
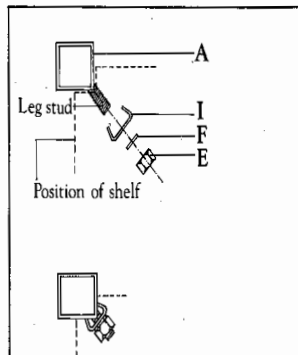

Locate the shelf (D) on to the leg studs ensuring that the channel at the top of the legs (A) face each other, i.e. point inwards. Make sure that the shelf is the correct way up. SEE FIG. 1.

NB. For stands with centre legs (studs on two opposite sides as shown in sketch above) locate the shelves (D) on to the centre legs first. The leg channels are located to the top with screws which are tightened by means of a screwdriver.

Ensure that the corner of the shelf (D) fits around the studs and legs (A) correctly. Place a self clamping cleat (I) over the leg stud and fix in position with a 10mm washer (F) and 10mm hexagon nut (E). Repeat procedure on all legs.

Assembly of stand to sink top or preparation table

1. Lay the sink or preparation table face down ensuring that the polished surface is protected from the floor.
2. Turn the stand assembly upside down and locate the leg channels on to the struts on the underside of the sink or preparation table ensuring that the holes in each line up.
3. Screw the legs to the sink or preparation table using the 8mm screws (C) and 8mm washers (H).
4. Fully tighten all the screws and nuts.
5. Remove the protective plastic coating from the shelf (D) and the sink or preparation table.
6. Adjust the plastic feet (C) to ensure that the completed unit stands level.
