

Locking Window Fastener - Fitting Instructions

<u>Note: Please choose to install the fastener on 'Right-hand side' or 'Left-hand side' of</u> the window.


1. Choose the location of the <u>latch plate</u> on the window frame at a height accessible to operate. *If the window frame in inclined, 'tapered base' latch plate would suit better.*



- 2. The curved part of the latch plate needs to be towards the window sash.
- 3. Mark the location of screw holes on window frame at distance of 12mm from the edge near sash. The screws holes are 25mm away from each other.



- 4. Drill the hole using 3mm drill bit and install the latch plate.
- 5. *Please ensure the window is closed.* Offer the <u>fastener</u> on the window sash such that flange of the latch plate sits flush inside the fastener.
- 6. Mark the location of the locking fastener holes on the window frame. The holes of the fastener are 40mm apart.





9. To Lock the Window: Grip the end of the fastener and turn the handle down fully in-line to sit flush against latch plate. Turn and remove the key. Do not leave the key in the lock.



Latch Plate 'Flange' must sit flush inside the Locking Fastener
