



Full Pedestal Basins

Assembly and Installation Instructions



Parts Supplied - Full pedestal basin pack



Tools Required (not supplied)

- Adjustable Spanner
- Screwdriver
- Spirit Level
- Tape Measure


- Pencil or Marker Pen
- Power Drill and suitable bit(s)
- Waterproof Sealant


Before You Start

- Check the pack and make sure you have all the parts listed. If not, contact the vendor who will be able to help you.
- When you are ready to start, make sure that you have the right tools to hand, plenty of space and a clean, dry area for assembly.
- Ensure the water feed and waste connection points are positioned appropriately for the installation.
- **Caution:** Care should always be taken when drilling into walls and floors to avoid any sunken wires or pipes.
- Please Note: Although these instructions are comprehensive, it is always recommended that a technically competent installer should undertake installation.

Basin and Full Pedestal - Assembly

- Fit the taps and waste fittings to the basin in accordance with the instructions provided.
- Place the basin on the pedestal close to the wall and carefully move into the final installation position.
 Ensure the basin is level and is flush against the wall.
- 3. Mark the positions of the wall and the floor fixing holes, (if provided).
- 4. Drill and fit wall plugs if necessary.
- Secure the basin and pedestal using suitable fixings, making sure that the basin is level and fixed firmly.
 Do not overtighten the fixings as this may damage the basin.
- Connect water supply and waste connections.
 Check for leaks.
- 7. Seal interface between basin and wall using waterproof sealant.

These are our recommendations to make sure that your bathroom stays looking good:

Vitreous China - Ceramic Basins and Pedestals

Do's

Clean immediately after use to stop a build up of dirt and scale.

Use warm soapy water, cream or liquid cleaner.

Fix dripping taps – this stops stain and limescale build up.

Occasional use of mild bathroom lime scale removers is acceptable.

Use in accordance with manufacturers instructions, rinsing well with plenty of water.

Don't

Never mix different cleaners – they can react to give off poisonous gas.
